Following a European initiative, rural parishes across the country have been compiling parish action plans. Ecclesfield has been included in this process along with its neighbouring villages. Each individual village has produced a separate resident questionnaire, analysed the results and is now in the process of translating these into an action plan. An action plan is a simple way of defining a strategy to see something done about the issues that matter most to YOU. 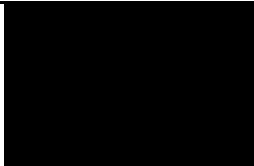
It is intended that a reviewing process will take place at regular intervals to report on the progress of the village plan projects, details will be given on our webpage and in the local press.
