## Drop In Service

Sheffield Futures operates a drop in service for adults living or working in Sheffield, as part of the local Nextstep service.

The adviser will be able to spend up to 20 minutes with you on drop in for an initial discussion about your circumstances and needs relating to learning and work. This may include advice, signposting to other services or access to our resource base for further information.

You may also be eligible for an in-depth guidance appointment which can be arranged as part of the drop in service.
